**REQUIRED ELEMENTS (unit must complete ALL required elements prior to December 31, 2022)**

<b>R1</b>	Our Unit achieved <b>Journey to Excellence Bronze Status or better</b> for 2022. Link to scorecards here <a href="#">Unit   Boy Scouts of America (scouting.org)</a> Workbooks here - <a href="#">Tracking Workbooks   Boy Scouts of America (scouting.org)</a>
<b>R2</b>	Our Unit submitted a completed online Charter Renewal on or before December 10, 2022.
<b>R3</b>	Our Unit held a <b>Friends of Scouting (FOS) Campaign</b> in 2022 where all families were given an opportunity to contribute.
<b>R4</b>	Our Unit will be represented at the <b>Foothills District Banquet</b> in February 2023.
<b>R5</b>	Our Unit participated in at least <b>Two Service Projects</b> in 2022, one being for our Charter Organization, <b>AND, reported the hours</b> online through the Internet Advancement Activities Portal - <a href="#">Login   Internet Advancement (scouting.org)</a>
<b>R6</b>	Our Unit provided a minimum of 1 Leader for each 20 registered youth (11/1/22 roster) <b>to actively serve</b> as members of a 2022 District or Council Committee or Commissioner Staff. ( <i>Advancement, Camping, Communications, Community Activities, Cub Activities, Finance, Health and Safety, Membership, Public Relations, Religious Relations, Training, Venturing Activities, Special Needs Scouting, Commissioner Team (Unit Commissioner, Roundtable Commissioner, Asst District Commissioner, etc.) (Member at Large listing alone does not qualify).</i> )
<b>R7</b>	Our Unit provided a minimum of 1 Adult Staff for each 20 registered youth (11/1/22 roster) in their Unit to one or more 2022 District Events. Troops and Crews may use youth volunteers to qualify for this element. <i>examples: Camporall, Webelos Woods, Day Camp, District Cub Family Camping, FOS Presenter or Golden Eagle Table Host, etc.</i>

**ELECTIVE ELEMENTS (complete and circle at least 7 of 10 elements)**

<b>E1</b>	<b>ROUNDTABLE:</b> Our Unit was represented at a minimum of 8 of 12 District Roundtables in 2022.	<b>E6</b>	<b>FUNDRAISING:</b> Our Unit participated in the Council annual product sales - Popcorn and/or Camp Cards.
<b>E2</b>	<b>UNIFORM INSPECTION:</b> Our Unit participated in a uniform inspection conducted by a Unit Commissioner prior to Charter Renewal.	<b>E7</b>	<b>DISTRICT/COUNCIL EVENTS:</b> Our youth participated in at least one District or Council events. <i>ex: Camporall, Webelos Woods, Day Camp, Family Camping, Cub World Events, Venturing Roundtable, COPE, Venturing Leadership Skills, etc.</i>
<b>E3</b>	<b>COMMISSIONER CONTACTS:</b> Our Unit participated in at least 4 Unit Commissioner Contacts one of which is a Detailed Assessment prior to Unit Charter Renewal	<b>E8</b>	<b>ORDER OF THE ARROW:</b> Our Unit was represented with signed in attendance a minimum 5 of 12 OA monthly chapter meetings AND at least 1 Lodge Event other than the OA Winter Banquet in 2022.
<b>E4</b>	<b>RECRUITMENT:</b> Our Unit participated in an organized recruiting campaign in which a unit presentation was made to prospective scouts and parents. <i>ex: Rally Night, Signup Night, Open House, etc.</i>	<b>E9</b>	<b>FAMILY PARTICIPATION:</b> Our Unit provided at least one opportunity for family participation. <i>ex: Blue &amp; Gold Banquet, Familycookout, Family Camping, Holiday Dinner, Pinewood Derby, Bike Rodeo, Court of Honor, etc. Do not count regular unit meetings.</i>
<b>E5</b>	<b>ADVANCED TRAINING:</b> Our Unit's Adult Leaders have participated in an advanced training opportunity in 2022. <i>examples: B.A.L.O.O., University of Scouting, Commissioner College, Wood Badge, Powder Horn, Certification Saturday, National Camp School, Climbing instructor, COPE instructor, Trainer Development, NYLT, Wilderness First Aid, BSA Lifeguard, Red Cross Lifeguard, SWC, etc. (Do not count onlinetraining)</i>	<b>E10</b>	<b>SCOUTING FOR FOOD:</b> Our Unit held a conscientious food collection campaign in which each member was given the opportunity to participate, <b>AND</b> reported the activity online at: <a href="#">Login   Internet Advancement (scouting.org)</a>
